The organising authority is Broadwater Sailing Club. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The following documents will apply; RYA Racing Charter, RYA Prescriptions, Class Rules and the Sailing Instructions of the event. Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore and nothing in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else reduces this responsibility. All competitors are required to hold third party insurance for racing of at least £2,000,000. Upon entry, competitors automatically give perpetual right and permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

1 SUPPLEMENTARY RULES FOR THIS EVENT

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and as amended by the Broadwater SC Sailing Instructions. The rule variation below, where they differ from the Broadwater SC SIs take precedent over the Broadwater SC SIs.

1.2 RRS Appendix P, as amended below, will apply: Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, shall apply, with RRS P2.1 to P2.3 deleted and replaced by:

P2.1 First and Second Penalty: When a boat is penalised under rule P1.2 for the first or second time during the event, her penalty shall be a Two-Turn Penalty under rule 44.2. If she fails to take the penalty she shall be disqualified without a hearing.

P2.2 Third and Subsequent Penalties: When a boat is penalised a third or subsequent time during the event, she shall promptly retire. If she fails to do so she shall be disqualified without a hearing and her score shall not be excluded. This measure does not prejudice a competitor's own right to protest a fellow competitor for breaking rule 42.

1.3 RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, applies:

When there is an incident that will not result in the lodging of a protest or a request for redress, a boat may request an advisory meeting and notify any boat involved in the incident. An adviser will then call a meeting to learn what may have happened and will state whether any rule appears to have been broken, and by which boat. A boat may, as a result, notify the race office that it accepts a Post-Race Penalty when it applies to the incident, or choose to retire, but is not required to do so.
