

**NOTICE OF RACE****Broadwater Spring Handicap Open Regatta****Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2026**

<b>Entries</b>	A maximum of 40 entries will be accepted.
<b>Entry fee</b>	By donation on the day. Free tea and coffee on tap. Bring your own lunch.
<b>Registration</b>	Registration on the day, from 10:00 until 15 minutes before the initial start.
<b>Briefing</b>	10.30
<b>Start of first race</b>	No earlier than 11.00 am. A 5min warning signal will be given prior to start.
<b>Schedule</b>	<b>3</b> races, with a break for lunch, followed by prize giving.
<b>Scoring/Prizes</b>	Best 2 of 3 races to count. If conditions restrict the number of races held, then no discard shall be allowed. Prizes awarded to 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> places. Other prizes shall be at the discretion of the organisers.
